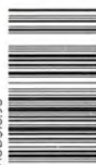

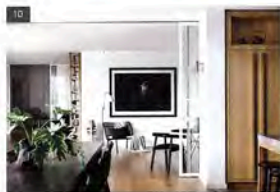

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10. **Blanche Street** D- Nison Tulloch Fortey Architecture P- Tom Ross

Créolisme's unique environment created an opportunity for exploring an interaction between industrial and Heritage dwellings. The resulting home is unexpected and innovative, architecturally inspired while referencing its context in scale and form. A solution of six shipping containers allowed a vertically manipulated volume that is playful and brutal yet finely detailed.

11. **Brick house** D- Andrew Burgess Architects P- Peter Bennetts

Located within a varied, tightly scaled streetscape in North Bondi, this two-storey home for a young family connects the site to the broader context of Sydney's geography, landscape and sky, while creating privacy and separation between neighbours through careful manipulations of site topography and enclosure.

12. **Brighton** D- Doherty Design Studio P- Sean Fennessy

A uniquely personalised interior that is both modern and timeless distinguishes this project. Led by a monochrome palette and characterised by a somewhat feminine aesthetic, the design breathes lightly while striking a balance between a new pared-back aesthetic and allowing existing features to shine. The result is a home that balances classic and contemporary.

13. **Brougham Place** D- Smart Design Studio P- Ross Honeysett

Recognisably modernist, this courtyard dwelling is both art and architecture. The outside is bold: multicoloured louvers within a concrete and sandstone facade, a deliberately contemporary use of a Heritage palette and materials. Inside is finely detailed with each wall and joinery item crafted to slide, pivot, unfold and reveal its secrets.

14. **Caulfield house** D- Beatrix Rowe Interior Design P- Sharny Cairns

While speaking to the strong 60s feel of the house, new life and energy was introduced. The joinery is designed with attention to detail, highlighting craftsmanship and quality construction. Spaces were re-imagined to optimise flow, emphasise changeable light and balance visual warmth in the material selection with crisp white and clean lines.

15. **Church house** D- Georgina Cannon Interior Design P- Cathy Schuster

A spectacularly modern addition to a beautiful, Heritage-listed church, the Church house is home to an active family of four, along with their two dogs Billy and Julia. The design features minimal, robust finishes with a touch of glamour and beautiful yet functional wet areas and joinery.

16. **DDH residence** D- Min Design P- Sharny Cairns

Designed by Harry Ernest in 1964, the home's new design honours and reimagines it to create a new lease of life for a modern young family. The design celebrates the mid-century aspect of the house, through the introduction of a light, bright and welcoming ambience, while retaining the integrity of the interior mid-century features that are all too often lost.

17. **DRF residence** D- Min Design P- Sharny Cairns

A modern sanctuary that pays homage to the Edwardian architectural style through the layering of materials, a soft palette of greys and off-whites with accents of black. Delivering old school glamour, the bathrooms feature new black steel window frames and doors, custom light fittings, a sculptural fireplace and Buster + Punch handles.

18. **Freshwater apartment** D- John Wardle Architects P- Sharny Cairns

A series of divisions and operable partitions within the apartment have responded to the clients' need for greater flexibility, whereby some spaces allow the family to come together. Moreover, the design works splendidly to maximise the views out to Port Phillip Bay and beyond.

19. **Gibbon Street** D- Cavill Architects P- Christopher Frederick Jones

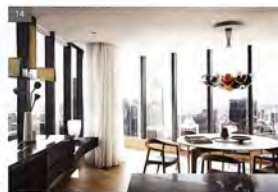
Inspired by architecture with veneration for the past, the additions were imagined as a series of relic-like garden walls repurposed to accommodate a practical living environment. The philosophy implicit in this concept is the suspension of time, a wild experience, distinguished from the regularity of modern built environments.

20. **Halo house** D- Beatrice Architecture P- Dianna Snape

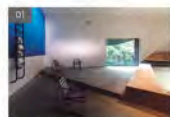
Drawing inspiration from the Halo Effect, the project takes the form of a faceted, textural 'iceberg' from the outside, and a protected yet lofty refuge internally. Halo house acts as a provider and protector for its inhabitants, granting a young family a sanctuary in which to grow and thrive.

21. **High Noon** D- Clare Cousins Architects P- Shannon McGrath

Idyllically set among Victoria's coastal bushland, High Noon is filled with character - a thoughtfully detailed permanent home for a young family of five. With abundant access to functional outdoor spaces, the design enables an independent, nature-loving childhood for its three younger inhabitants.



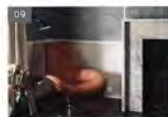
